## **COMPREHENSIVE OVERVIEW:**

- Amount is subject to change as per the prevailing USD exchange rate.
- Initial Year One-Time Charges include Acceptance letter, Admission fee, Transaction Processing, Ministry Approval, Document Conversion and Registration Services, Police verification, Airport Pickup in Uzbekistan, Pre-departure and post-arrival assistance.
- Charges for mess and hostel accommodation are applied per academic year.
- The student is accountable for covering the costs of the student visa and airfare.
- Visa Extension and Registration will be payable as per actual Government Regulations and Charges.
- Laundry rooms are available in all hostels, equipped with washing machines and can be accessed by students.
- A provisional amount of \$50 per year may be charged for contingent expenses, if required.
- Flexible payment options are available for fees, including both annual and semester wise.

NOTE: INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY IN HOSTEL FOR ATLEAST ONE YEAR

## **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSION:**

- Valid Passport (with at least 18 months to 5 years validity)
- Class 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> marksheet (min. 50%)
- NEET scorecard (qualifying, valid for the current or previous two years)
- Passport size photograph
